ORDINANCE NO. 700

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING THE 2012 REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUISVILLE, CLAY COUNTY, ILLINOIS (NO SUBSTANTIVE CHANGES)

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code of the Village of Louisville, Illinois has not been formally updated for several years; and

WHEREAS, the Village has now revised its Municipal Code to include and reflect all additions, modifications, and deletions thereto by ordinances properly approved that have been made since the last adoption of said Code made on September 9, 2004;

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Louisville, Clay County, Illinois have determined that these certain sections should be rearranged and placed differently in the said Municipal Code for the sake of consistency and readability and that various typographical errors should be corrected; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance does not make any substantive changes to the current law of the Village of Louisville but rather simply rearranges certain sections and makes such typographical corrections therein its Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUISVILLE, CLAY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: The Village Board of Trustees finds as facts the recitals hereinabove set forth.

Section 2: The following Exhibit "A" shall be the "2012 Revised Code of Ordinances" of the Village of Louisville, Clay County, Illinois (which has also been known and sometimes referred to as the "Municipal Code of the Village of Louisville, IL), and said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as shown in Exhibit "A".

SEE EXHIBIT "A" FOLLOWING (for purposes of the original ordinance and its storage in the Village's permanent file, Exhibit "A" shall not be physically attached to said original ordinance but is rather incorporated therein by reference to that bound booklet entitled "2012 Revised Code of Ordinances" as was presented to the Board of Trustees at its regular board meeting held on March 8, 2012 - a copy of this Ordinance shall be placed in the front of each bound booklet entitled "2012 Revised Code of Ordinance")

Section 3: If any part or provision of this Ordinance should be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in direct conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are related to, but not in direct conflict with this ordinance, shall remain in effect. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of a

previous Ordinance that is repealed due to this instant provision shall not affect the validity of any other part of said previous Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts. Should any part or parts of this Ordinance be later determined invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
